



Official Rules for the Intel Student Photo Contest Fall 2011 Recruiting Season

These rules, including the www.intel.com Privacy Notice and Terms of Use, (the "Rules") govern the **Intel Student Photo Contest**, comprised of Phase I and Phase II (as defined below) (collectively referred to as the "Contest") and set out the terms and conditions between Intel Corporation and its affiliates ("Intel," "Sponsor," or "us/we") and each participant ("participant" or "you"). An entry or submission to this Contest constitutes your acceptance of these Official Contest Rules (the "Rules").

1. How to Enter

Phase I: No Purchase Necessary. A purchase or payment will not increase your chances of winning. Winners must be present to win. Prize winners will be chosen in random drawings held during an Intel information session or networking event to be held at each of the below universities as follows:

Complete an official entry form with your first name, last name, and email address and drop it into the drawing box provided at the designated table at one of the Intel Tech Sessions listed above to be entered into a drawing to be held at the end of that Intel Tech Session for a chance to win an Intel Rock Star T-shirt and entry into Phase II of the Contest. For each drawing, all entries must be received by the close of that Intel Tech Session (i.e., the close of the Phase I Entry Period corresponding to a given Intel Tech Session). Limit one entry per person per Tech Session. To be eligible for a drawing, entries for each drawing must be received prior to the scheduled drawing time. No responsibility is assumed for lost, late, mutilated, misdirected, incomplete, or inaccurate entries. Entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned.

Phase II: Intel Corporation is offering the "Contest" and will award prizes based on the results of judging all valid entries against the criteria established in these Rules. Only winners of Phase I are eligible for entry in Phase II. To enter Phase II, winners of Phase I must submit between **9/12/2011, 12:00 a.m. (PDT) and 11/26/2011, 11:59 p.m. (PST)** (the "Phase II Entry Period") a photo that includes the Intel Rock Star T-shirt (you do NOT have to WEAR the shirt in the photo, but the shirt must be visible in the photo in order to be considered an entry) for a chance to win additional prizes. All entries must be in English. During the Phase II Entry Period, submit your entry to Photocontest@Intel.com.

2. **Eligibility**

All national and local laws and regulations of the contestant's country and state of residence apply. Void where prohibited.

Phase I: Phase I of the Contest is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who have reached the age of majority in their state of residence at the time of entry and who are attendees of one of the Intel Tech Sessions listed in Section 1 of the Rules. For avoidance of doubt, you are eligible only for the drawing at the Intel Tech Session that you attend. Employees of Sponsor and its parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, distributors, advertising and promotion agencies, and other vendors or independent contractors providing services to Sponsor in connection with the Intel Tech Sessions, and members of the immediate family (defined as spouse, parent, sibling, child and respective spouses regardless of where they reside) and/or those living in the same household of such employees are NOT ELIGIBLE to enter.

Phase II: Phase II of the Contest is open only to winners of Phase I.

3. **Entries/Submissions**

Sponsor is not responsible for incorrect or inaccurate entry information, whether caused by you or any other persons or for any lost, late, mutilated, misdirected, incomplete, inaccurate or postage due entries. Sponsor is not responsible for contest entries not received due to lost, failed, delayed or interrupted connections or miscommunications, or other electronic malfunctions, for electronic transmission errors resulting in omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, or for technical, network, telephone equipment, electronic, computer, hardware or software malfunctions or limitations of any kind, or inaccurate transmissions of or failure to receive entry information by Sponsor or presenter on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any Web site or any combination thereof. Entries are void if they contain material typographical or other errors. Proof of submission does not constitute proof of receipt. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an online entrant, the prize will be awarded to the authorized account holder of the email address. The "authorized account holder" is defined as the natural person to whom the email address is assigned by an internet service provider, online service provider or other organization (e.g., business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. If, for any reason, the Internet portion of the program is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Contest, Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest. Sponsor reserves the right to select winners from eligible entries received as of the termination date. Sponsors further reserve the right to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process. Sponsor may prohibit an entrant from participating in the Contest if it determines that said entrant is attempting to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest by cheating, hacking, deception or other unfair playing practices or intending to abuse, threaten or harass other entrants. Caution: Any attempt by a participant to deliberately damage any Web site or undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such participant to the fullest extent of the law.

4. **Judging**

Phase I Prize Drawing: Winners of the drawings at each Intel Tech Session for Phase I will be selected in a random drawing at the close of each Intel Tech Session (i.e., at the close of Phase I Entry Period corresponding to each of the Intel Tech Sessions listed in Section 1 from all eligible entries received). Prize drawings will be conducted by Intel representatives whose decisions on all

matters relating to this Contest are final and binding. Winners will be notified by announcement directly following the drawing at the Intel Tech Session. Winners must be present to win.

Phase II: Photograph submissions for Phase II ("Submissions") will be judged on 11/29/2011 by the following Intel Employees: Tiffany Peery, Marketing Program Manager; Allen Stephens, Marketing Program Manager; Keith Pearce, Compensation and Benefits Manager; Eric Manton, Social Media Strategist; and Michele Gartner, Community Manager. Judges will evaluate all eligible submissions on the following criteria: creativity and enthusiasm in photo content that includes the Intel Rock Star T-shirt. Judges decisions are final. You may withdraw your Submission at any time by notifying Sponsor. If a Submission is withdrawn, your right to win a prize is terminated.

5. **Ownership and Publicity**

Phase I: Entries for the Phase I drawing become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned.

Phase II: Sponsor does not claim ownership of your Submission to the Contest; but by submitting a Submission, you are granting Sponsor and its affiliated companies the following worldwide, non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, unconditional, fully paid-up rights: (1) to make, have made, use, copy, reproduce, modify, and create derivative works of the Submission, (2) to publicly perform or display, import, broadcast, transmit, distribute (directly and indirectly through multiple tiers), license, offer to sell and sell, rent, lease, or lend copies of the Submission (and derivative works thereof), (3) to sublicense to third parties the foregoing rights, including the right to sublicense to further third parties, and (4) to publish your name or alias in connection with this contest and your Submission.

Contestants understand and agree that their Submission may be posted and publicly viewable. By providing a Submission, you grant Sponsor and its affiliated companies the right, except where prohibited by law, to use your name for promotional purposes in promoting or publicizing the contest. Sponsor, however, does not have any obligation to use the winning Submission for any purpose.

6. **Participant Warrants**

By submitting an entry in Phase II, you warrant that your Submission:

- does not contain any content that infringes on any third party intellectual Property (IP) rights or rights of publicity, and that you own or otherwise have all rights necessary for the Submission including any and all IP rights
- does not disclose any information which would constitute a violation of a confidentiality obligation;
- does not contain any viruses, worms, spy ware, or other components or instructions that are malicious, deceptive, or designed to limit or harm the functionality of a computer; and
- is not subject to license terms that require any software or documentation incorporating or being derived from your Submission to be licensed to others.

7. **Prizes**

Prizes/Retail Value and Odds of Winning for Phase I: 400 Intel Rock Star T-shirts (10 to be awarded at each Intel Tech Session) (Value \$8.00 per T-shirt, total of \$3200 for all T-shirts). Limit of one Intel Rock Star T-shirt per person. Each Phase I winner will also be eligible to enter Phase II. Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received. Prize consists of only those items specifically listed as part of the prize. All prizes are awarded "as is" with no warranties, representations or guarantees, including but not limited to, quality, condition, merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Winners must look to the manufacturer for any warranties or guarantees. No transfer or substitution of prizes, except by Sponsor in the event an advertised prize is not available. In such cases, Sponsor may substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Taxes on prize are the sole responsibility of the winners.

Phase II: Three prizes will be awarded upon the end of judging. Prizes will consist of

- **1st prize** – Samsung 9 Series Laptop with Core i5 processor (Value ~1300\$)
- **2nd prize** – 40" Internet TV with Intel Processor (Value ~700\$)
- **3rd prize** – Netbook with an Intel Atom Processor (Value ~300\$)

Limit of one prize per Submission. Winners will be notified via **e-mail and by blog post:** <http://blogs.intel.com/jobs> within **10** of days from judging. Blog post will go live on November 30 announcing winners and will showcase the photo content of the winners. If, after seven (7) days of the second notification to the winner, no acknowledgement or response is received the prize is forfeited, and Sponsor will select another winner.

Winners of either Phase may be required to complete an Eligibility Confirmation and a Liability/Publicity Release (unless prohibited by law). The Confirmation and the Release must be returned within ten (10) days of receipt of these documents. Non-compliance with any of these requirements may result in disqualification, in which case an alternate winner may be chosen. Physical prizes will be shipped to winners within **two weeks** from the date of the return the completed Affidavit of Eligibility and/or Liability/Publicity Release.

Substitution or transfer of Prizes are not allowed, and Prizes may not be redeemed for cash. If a Prize becomes unavailable or is prohibited by law, Sponsor may at its sole discretion award a substitute prize of equal or greater value. The winner accepts responsibility for all federal, state and local taxes and fees in connection with the prizes. Apart from prizes offered as part of the contest, no monetary compensation will be paid for any of your contest entries or Submissions.

Sponsor does not provide any warranty on the prize, and winner should look solely to manufacturer for warranty.
